

The surface on deck is symmetrical; the following description covers both starboard and port hulls. With the exception of the extreme stern area and on top of the bridgedeck cabin, all deck space may be used for laying out, sitting, etc.

Bow: extremely comfortable, curved laying space to sunbathe, relax and chat

Bowsprit: sitting or lying area: 465 cm long, 120-25 cm wide

Bow-net, great for schmoozing, afternoon nap, etc., 260 x 290 cm.

Sunning bench, altogether 580 cm long

Sloping-Front: very comfortable curved laying area for 2 people, for reading, dozing, observation, etc.

Center bench, which folds to become a laying space.

With both benches folded down, the heart of the deck becomes one gigantic sleeping area

Large upholstered laying area, approx. 220 x 240 cm.

Central platform, 400 x 380 cm.

Ideal space for meetings, dancing, dining terrace, etc.

When not under sail, this area is usually covered with a sunroof, (or rainroof, depending on weather!)

Sloping-Front: very comfortable curved laying area for 2 people, for reading, dozing, observation, etc.

Sunning bench, 580 cm long

Stem-Platform altogether 260 x 560 cm.
